Sun Safety

Research sun safety - understand why it is so important to stay safe in the sun. Design a poster promoting the importance of sun safety. Make sure you include images and text.

Cardiovascular System

Research the cardiovascular system - What is it? How does it work? Which parts of the body does it involve? Learn about how oxygen moves around the body. Use the picture of the lungs and heart to label the key parts of the organ and show how the cardiovascular system works.
