### Science

#### Garden Survey

Move around your garden or the local park area. Note down all the plants and animals that you find in the garden or park. Create a fact file about all the animals and plants you have found.

#### The importance of drinking fluids

Why is it important to drink fluids such as water, milk and squash. What fluids are good for you? What fluids aren't so good for you? Create an information leaflet explaining why it is important to drink fluids especially water and milk.

### Art

#### Newspaper art

Create a picture using old newspapers or magazines. If you have any newspaper or magazines at home which are finished with and some glue (scissors can be used if you have some or you could just rip the paper,) you could try making a collage.



#### Circle Art

What can fit inside a circle? Draw a circle and see what you can draw inside of it. Get a cup to draw around and make as many circles that you can fit onto your paper. Use a pen or pencil to draw as many things that you can think of that could fit in the circles. If you have any crayons, felt tips or paints you could add some colour.
