physical geography	The part of geography concerned with natural features such as mountains, volcanoes, rivers and climate.	
human geography	The part of geography dealing with how people affect the earth such as settlements and communities.	
topography	The study of the shape and features of land surfaces.	
climate	The usual temperature, wind, humidity, snow, and rain in a place over time.	
grid reference	Showing locations in maps using coordinates.	
population	The number of people who live in a particular place including: towns, cities, countries, continents and the world.
