Key Vocabulary	Definition
<u>Tone</u>	The lightness or darkness of an image (eg: shade).
<u>Texture</u>	Perceived surface quality of art with 2d and 3d properties.
<u>Collage</u>	Pasting various materials on to a single surface to create a new effect or image.
<u>Pitch</u>	How high or low a sound is depending the frequency.
<u>Tempo</u>	How fast or slow the music is (pace).
Mood	The feeling created by a piece of music. This could be dependent on the instruments, pitch, tempo and volume.
